

Mr. CHANG Nan, 48 years old, graduated from Harbin Shipbuilding Engineering Institute in 1982 with a bachelor degree of Nuclear Engineering.

He started his career with China Institute of Atomic Energy in 1982, worked as Operator Assistant, Operator, Senior Operator, Shift Supervisor, Deputy Chief & Chief of Operation Section, being responsible for operation of heavy water research reactor for 7 years and implemented the in-core testing of prototype fuel

assembly of NPP in the reactor for Qinshan Phase One.

He became a senior engineer of Ministry of Energy in 1989, spending 4 years in Guangdong Nuclear power Joint Venture Corporation for starting up & putting the first unit of Dayabay Nuclear Power Plant into commercial operation.

In 1995, he was nominated Deputy Director of Nuclear Power Bureau in China National Nuclear Corporation (CNNC) with responsibility for operation management of nuclear power plants in China.

From 1996 to 2005, he served first as Deputy Director General, then Director General of Jiangsu Nuclear Power Corporation being responsible for all activities related to the engineering and construction of Tianwan nuclear power project.

In 2005, he was appointed Director-General of Nuclear Power Department, China Power Investment Corporation (CPI), one of the five largest national Gencos of China, the mother company of Haiyang AP1000 project, a position he holds at the present time.
