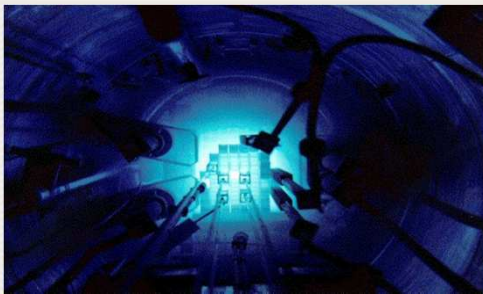

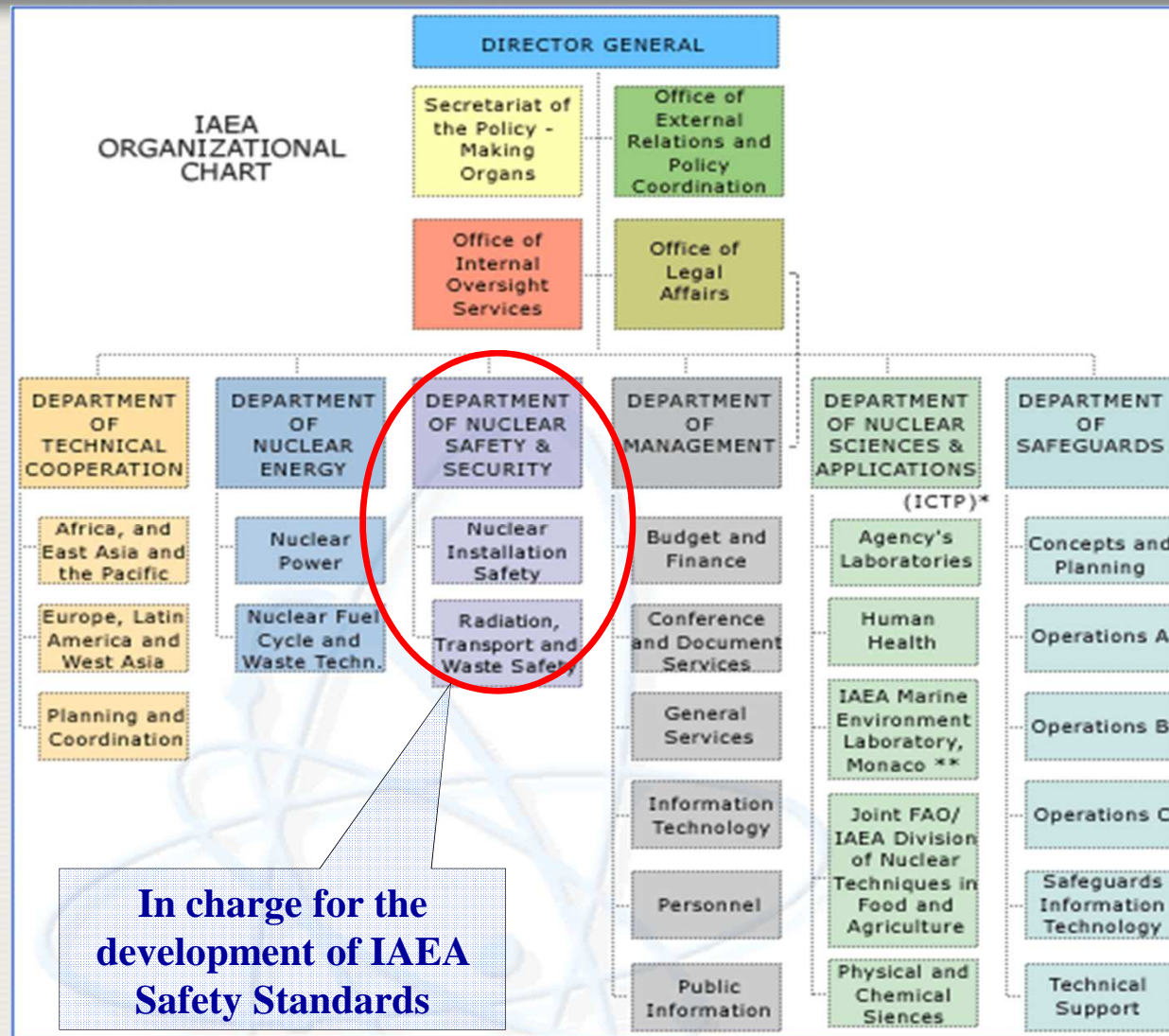


Nuclear facilities in the world

- **440 nuclear reactors in operation in 30 countries, 31 under construction and 117 shut-down**
- **About 280 research reactors in 56 countries continue to operate, but some 670 research reactors have been built to date**
