I have the honor to refer to email dated Wednesday, September 7, 2016 the department of energy technique and nuclear science of the ministry of mines and energy would like to submit the National Reports under the Convention on Nuclear Safety, as follow:

**1. Legislative and Regulatory Framework**

The Cambodia not establish the Legislative and Regulatory Framework to govern the safety of nuclear installation yet. There is only one Nuclear Material that used in Cambodia. The Legislative and Regulatory Framework will be design by Regulatory Authority after the Nuclear Law entry into force.

## **2. Regulatory Body**

The Cambodia not establish Regulatory Body yet. The Regulatory Body will establish after The Nuclear Law of Kingdom of Cambodia entry into force.

## **3. Emergency Preparedness**

The Cambodia not establish Emergency Preparedness yet. In fact, Cambodia was established the Law on Prohibition of Chemical, Nuclear, Biological and Radiological Weapons, 03 Dec 1993. This law, was established The National Authority for the prevention of Chemical, Nuclear, Biological and Radiological Weapons namely "National Authority of Chemical Weapons" that respond on emergency activities.
