Working group participants on Administrative controls:

- > 15 Participants, consisting of:
 - 7 Operators,
 - 8 Regulators and TSO/Consultants.
- > 12 countries.

Items

Key items identified to address the Administrative controls:

- > Organisation of work
- > Safety management system
- > Safety parameters
- > Training and skills
- > Emergency arrangements

Issues

Key issues identified to address the Administrative controls:

- Organisation of work
 - Progressive removal of safety functions and related SSCs (sequence of work)
 - Implementation of new safety functions and related SSCs.
 - Implementation of temporary safety function and SSCs for single action or during a very short period of time.
- > Safety management system
 - Decision making process for removal of safety functions and SSCs
 - Safety management systems of the operator vs contractors

Issues

Key issues identified to address the Administrative controls:

- > Safety parameters
 - Summary of the SA results of all the tasks to be performed to identify the boundary limits of the facility (for normal and accident situations): What can be done (or not)?
 - Provide specific examples (ventilation systems, primary circuit, etc).
- > Training and skills
 - SA results may allow to identify a specific knowledge needed to perform a task
 - Training of operators on mock-ups is a good practice: training and optimisation of dismantling activities

Issues

Key issues identified to address the Administrative controls:

- > Emergency arrangements
 - Check that emergency plan are adequate with decommissioning plan and consistent with safety assessments results
 - Updates of emergency arrangements during decommissioning, if needed

Work methodology:

- > Text to be developed for items and issues identified
- Member States examples:
 - Collect experience feedback for very specific tasks (dismantling of heat exchangers) related to safety functions, SCCs and limits and conditions.
 - Work procedures are provided by the operator to the contractor (Argentina)
 - example of structures of operating rules for decommissioning (France)
 - knowledge management or ventilation system...topic to be confirmed (Netherlands)
 - Additional examples of dismantling activities to be confirmed (Armenia, South Africa)
 - Others?

Work plan will be consistent with the others WG organisation (May/June meetings)
