Working Groups (WGs)

- Formation of three WGs
 - WG 1: Safety and regulatory aspects
 - WG 2: Dismantling activities
 - WG 3: Materials management, including release of buildings and site clean-up
- One person per country per WG
- Romanian colleagues are welcome to join the WGs, but they should not review their own work
- Co-ordinate the scope of work amongst the WGs to avoid <u>unnecessary</u> duplications
- Ask for 'Briefings', as necessary

Tasks (1)

- The DP was reviewed in homework
- Discuss your findings in the respective WG
- Use the comments received before the workshop as input to the WG discussions
- Check the DP for its contents, e.g.
 - Is it complete?
 - Is everything correct?
 - Did you find any contradictions?
 - Is the plan feasible?
 - Will the work be carried out safely?

- Agree on findings and report the results
